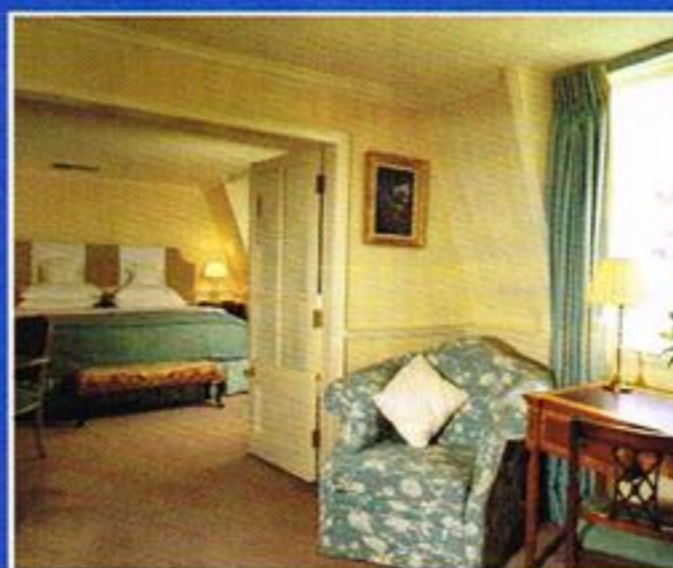

HISTORY AND ENGLISH ELEGANCE IN BATH

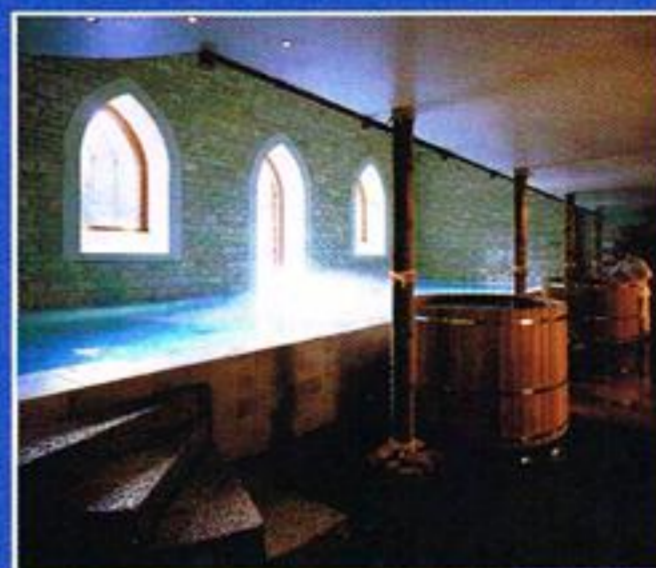
